For every additional family member, the living space increases by 10 m². If there are special reasons justifying a larger flat, larger flats may also be approved.

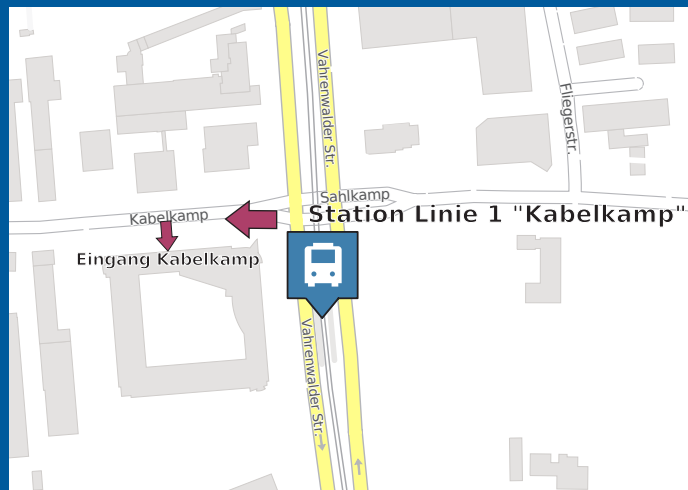

Language learning, job search
 and basic financial benefit

When do I receive benefits from the Jobcenter Region Hannover?

In order to receive basic benefits (unemployment benefit II) from the job centre, the following requirements must be fulfilled:

- You have a valid residence title
- You are in need of assistance, meaning you do not have enough money to live on
- You live in the Region Hannover
- You can work for at least three hours per day

Should you be in doubt whether you can work at least three hours per day, please talk to us about it.

Who pays for the doctor's visit?

In Germany, the costs for medical care are borne by the health insurance providers. The health insurance is free for you, because the Jobcenter Region Hannover bears the costs for you until you have taken up employment and can secure your livelihood yourself.

You will choose your health insurance provider yourself. You will submit the following documents to the health insurance provider:

- a valid residence title and your passport
- a current passport photo
- cancellation decision of the asylum seeker benefits

You will receive a membership certificate from your health insurance provider. You have to submit the certificate to the Jobcenter Region Hannover.

Which documents do I have to submit when filing my application?

For the Jobcenter Region Hannover to be able to review and approve your application, you have to present the following documents:

- completed application documents
- a valid residence title and your passport,
- passports and residence titles of the next of kin who live with you (wife/husband/your own children),
- proof of your place of residence,
- proof of your income,
- proof of your assets, if you have any
- your bank details

Which benefits do I receive from the Jobcenter Region Hannover?

You will receive money for your livelihood at the beginning of every month from the Jobcenter Region Hannover. This includes a fixed amount you can use for food, clothing and other everyday necessities. The amount is based on your age and on whether you are living alone or with a partner.

If you are pregnant or raising children alone, you will receive additional money.

Furthermore, you will receive rent for a flat and the necessary heating costs. You have to forward this money to your landlord (see overview Upper rent limits*).

If you have income or assets at your disposal, you will receive less money from the Jobcenter Region Hannover

I have children. Which benefits can I receive for my children from the Jobcenter Region Hannover?

Depending on the age of your children, you will receive a fixed amount you can use for food, clothing and other everyday necessities. Furthermore, you will receive a part of your rent costs proportionately for every child.

In addition, you can receive other benefits:

- costs for school supplies,
- lunch at school or day nurseries,
- costs for tutoring at school,
- membership fees for a sports club or music lessons,
- costs for field trips at school or the day nursery.

You will receive the costs for school supplies automatically in August and in February. Please present a certificate of school attendance for this purpose.

For lunch, sports clubs and music lessons, you will receive a qualification certificate from the job centre automatically.

Please apply for the costs for tutoring directly with the Jobcenter Region Hannover.

I want to move into a flat. What do I have to do?

The Jobcenter Region Hannover does not arrange any flats. The housing office of your city or municipality can support you in your search for a flat.

Of course, you can search for a flat on the open housing market as an alternative.

Before signing a rental contract, you have to present a rental offer or the rental contract (not signed) to the Jobcenter Region Hannover.

If the flat is appropriate (size and price), the Jobcenter Region Hannover will agree to renting. Reference figures to consider see overview Upper rent limits*. Then you can sign the rental contract. You will present the signed rental contract to the Jobcenter Region Hannover.

For a rental flat, you usually have to make a security deposit. Should you not have the money for the deposit, you can apply for a loan with the Jobcenter Region Hannover.

I need furniture and other items for my flat. What can I do?

If you need furniture and other items for your flat, you can get benefits for it from the job centre.

File an application with the Jobcenter Region Hannover and present the signed rental contract.

I would like to learn German. How will the Jobcenter Region Hannover help me?

If your application for unemployment benefit II has been approved, the Jobcenter Region Hannover will support you in finding a suitable course. Here, you will learn German and acquire knowledge about the Federal Republic of Germany.

How does the Jobcenter Region Hannover support me in my job search?

The Jobcenter Region Hannover staff will gladly provide you with information on qualification and training as well as with support in the job search in a personal meeting.
